Coach notes	<p>Route</p> <p>Group A</p> <p>Walk from Silverhill Lane through Silverhill Wood Park then to Teversal. Join lane to Norwood Lodge. Head into Lady Spencer's Wood, Hardwick Hall Estate, then row of trees to Glapwell. Continue to Stoney Houghton and then to Scarcliffe.</p> <p>Group B</p> <p>Similar route starting at Hardwick Hall.</p> <p>Afternoon route</p> <p>Bolsover direction.</p>

Descend to Hope.</p> <p>Group B</p> <p>2nd drop off Castleton Car Park, Cross Street, S33 8WH or Bamford</p> <p>Start at Castleton or Bamford. Ascend to Mam Tor. Go north-east to Lose Hill, then descend to Hope.</p> <p>Afternoon walk</p> <p>To Bradwell. About 3 miles</p>

Coach notes:	Route
1 st drop off Drop Groups A and B at Peak Village Shopping Outlet, DE4 2JE	Group A Head SW. through Rowsley village to Congreave. Head generally S. up to Stanton Moor. Cross Stanton Moor and drop SW into Birchover and Rowtor Rocks. Wind W. to Hermits Cave and Robin Hood's Stride. Head S into Elton, then pick up Limestone Way to Winster.
1 st Pick up Winster Car Park, Wensley Road, Winster, DE4 2DH	Group B Head SW. into Rowsley village. Take footpath S. which rises to Stanton Moor. Cross Stanton Moor and drop SW. into Birchover and Rowtor Rocks. Head W. to join Limestone Way and head south to Winster and pub.
2 nd pick up Main Road, B5057, Darley Bridge	<i>There is a short walk to the car park for the coach.</i> Afternoon walk Eastwards towards Darley Bridge

1 st pick up Ashford in the water	Group B From Monsal Head, go westwards over River Wye. Continue to Taddington. Head southeast, following River Wye to Ashford in the Water.
2 nd pick up Bakewell Showground and coach park, DE45 1AH	Distance: 7.3 miles Afternoon walk South-east to Bakewell

Continue west and north upto Langbar Moor then SW. past Black Foss Waterfall down to West Hall and over suspension bridge into Addingham.</p> <p>Group B</p> <p>Start near Blubberhouses Quarry, Kexgill Road Bridleway towards Kex Gill Farm. Cross A59 carefully and continue S. to Langbar Moor, then as A Group.</p> <p>Afternoon walk</p> <p>Follow Dales Way to Ilkley.</p>

Coach notes	<p>Route</p> <p>Group A Head into village past new and old church then N to Lumb Bank. Drop down, heading W to Callis Bridge and Hudson Mill Road. Turn right to Jack Bridge then left passing Jack Bridge Community Orchard. Turn left on Pennine Bridleway and head via Dukes Cut to Bridestones. Descend to Todmorden via Windy Harbour. Distance: About 9.5 miles</p> <p>2nd drop off TBC</p> <p>1st pick up Hare & Hounds, Burnley Road, Todmorden, OL14 8EA</p> <p>2nd pick up Either Gauxholme or Salford A6033</p> <p>Group B Head into village past new and old church then N to Lumb Bank. Keep on high ground, following Calderdale Way to Callis Bridge and Hudson Mill Road. Turn right to Jack Bridge then left passing Jack Bridge Community Orchard. Turn left on Pennine Bridleway. Continue generally SW to Bridestones. Pick a descent to Todmorden. Distance: About 7.5 miles</p> <p>Afternoon walk S. along Calderdale Way to Gauxholme or Salford. About 3 miles</p>

Take footpath across B6265 to High Lindrick, Galphay Wood and Galphay. Continue to Braithwaite Hall, and turn right to Azerley Park. Take minor road N to Frizer Hill. Pick a footpath down to Mickley and follow Ripon -Rowel to West Tanfield.</p> <p>Group B Start Studley Royal Bridleway. Go N to Low Lindrick. Pick up bridleway to Cow Myers & Azerley and onto Frizer Hill, then as Group A.</p> <p>Afternoon walk Follow River Ure SW to North Stainley.</p>

Continue to Kelham Island.</p> <p>Group B</p> <p>From Dropping Well, head south along dismantled railway to Blackburn. Join 5 Weirs Walk at Meadowhall and continue to Kelham Island.</p> <p>Afternoon walk</p> <p>North across Parkwood Springs.</p>

Coach notes	<p>Route</p> <p>Take footpath S. past Hall Leys Farm to Belph. Continue S to pick up the Harley Art Trail, going W. to Creswell Craggs. Follow Robin Hood Way through Creswell Craggs and through Holbeck. Take footpath SW to Cuckney. Continue SW to Mill Hill. Take path and track S. to Oakfield Plantation. Turn W. through Cuckney Hay Wood. At Top Farm, turn N. to Nether Langwith and pub.</p> <p>Distance: About 10.5 miles</p> <p>Group B</p> <p>Suggested route.</p> <p>From Creswell head east into Creswell Craggs. Follow Harley Art Trail E. to the Dukeries Garden Centre. Walk south and join Robin Hoods Way going SE to the outskirts of Norton. Take footpath SW to Cuckney. Continue south-west through village to Cuckney Pond. Take the permissive path W. to Langwith Mill House. Cross over A632. Head generally west through Cuckney Hay Wood to Nether Langwith.</p> <p>Distance: About 7.6 miles</p>
